""A lot of the kids weren't going to school. They were doing menial jobs to support their parents. I just got them together and started teaching them chess," Onakoya told Olympics.com ahead of World Mental Health Day - October 10. Since the inception of **Chess in Slums** in 2018, the organization has been dedicated to uplifting children from underserved communities through the strategic game of chess, STEM education, and socio-emotional development.

The organization is faced with countless business and marketing decisions every day. Many involve navigating industry traditions, otherwise known as rules, and many involve reacting to the way other brands are transforming those so-called traditions and rules.
